Hi, I was born in Prague, Smíchov. I went to elementary school graphically. I had a lot of friends there. We lived with a lot of Roma, so I didn't meet racism. We played a lot of sports, we played different games at school because we all knew each other as one big family and the headmistress Gross herself did dance ensembles for us there, so she promoted us there, so our culture because she knew we were mostly Roma, she addressed various musicians there who accompanied us in that dance ensemble. He was a legend of a woman, they called him Mr. Korytár. I got into the box so much that I was the thinnest in the group, so I was such a target. I attended the first training and it was on Americká Street in Vinohrady where there were coaches Jan Balog and Antonín Hauek, and when I opened the door, I didn't want to go there because, I heard the bombs there. So the coach, Jan Balog, told me that as soon as the door opened for him, I had to go inside. So my training was too hard for me because I didn't have an outfit, I came from a poor family, so I had calluses on my legs, I was sweating, but it was like a hero for me and I was looking forward to the next training. The coaches saw great potential in me, talent in me, so I raced. I've won a few matches, won. I was a multiple champion of the republic, I also participated in international tournaments. After those long breaks, I went back to boxing and thought that I had to wear those gloves. I have a good team around me. I train with the best topics, such as Vladimír Ježník, Václav Pejsar, Vasil Ducar, Pavol Šolud and others. We have a construction company with a family, so we are doing well and in Hradec they are handy and do business, so, as we know for ourselves that there is a lot of talent among young people and that I would like to develop it further with my colleagues who are also sportingly gifted, we need Alexander Srna and motivate them forward to try it in a ring between four ropes, between cages, because as we know, every child is talented, he has some talent in him. You would like to show today's youth not to run around the street, because there are a lot of sections or some dreams that they can fulfill. If it's education in sports and such, because if they will be active in sports, then look at the world, because times are bad. Take the example of Vašek Sivart, who traveled all over the world or Alexandr Smerna. These are our best wrestlers. Today, the sponsors go to them and offer them products, and they are happy about it, they have to work harder and work more than twenty percent to be better than the others,
